Introduction:

Pensacola State College (PSC), in collaboration with Savannah College of Art and Design (SCAD), has constructed an articulation transfer agreement in which PSC agrees to offer lower division courses leading up to the **SCAD Bachelor of Fine Arts in Graphic Design**.

Program Goal

The **Associate of Science in Graphic Design** is designed to prepare students to work in the field of graphic design as well as prepare students who wish to transfer into the **Bachelor of Fine Arts in Graphic Design** program at SCAD.

Articulated Associate of Science/Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Graphic Design:

Students will successfully complete the Associate of Science in Graphic Design at Pensacola State College:

Pensacola State College will indicate completion on the student's official transcript.

Students must apply and be accepted to SCAD. SCAD will accept all courses as indicated Below in the course equivalency table.

Agreement Provisions

1. Admission to Savannah College of Art and Design
2. The courses listed with SCAD equivalencies are currently transferable under the 2016-2017 SCAD course catalog for specific SCAD requirements for the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Graphic Design. Students are subject to the requirements of the SCAD course catalog in effect at the time of his or her entry and registration at SCAD. Students may choose to fulfill requirements of any subsequent SCAD course catalog within five years of their first enrollment at SCAD.
3. This document is specific to Pensacola State College's Graphic Design Associate of Science degree and the Savannah College of Art and Design's Bachelor of Fine Arts in Graphic Design. In order for a class to be considered for transfer, it needs to be at least three semester credit hours or five quarter hours. A grade of "C" or higher must be earned in the class. A course transferred from Pensacola State College may fulfill only one SCAD course requirement. A maximum of 18 courses may transfer into the SCAD BFA program of study. In some instances, a student's course selection may fulfill a different requirement than listed above. In those specific instances, it may be advantageous in the student's course of study to allow the course to fulfill a different requirement rather than a general education or free elective.

4. Updates

General: This agreement is subject to change by legislative action, the State Board of Education, the Division of Colleges and Universities, the Florida College System, the Florida Board of Governors, Savannah College of Art and Design, Pensacola State College or external accrediting agencies. This agreement will be reviewed by both parties on a yearly basis to ensure the currency of this document.

5. Resources

Resources for the implementation of this agreement may come from either party, depending on budget availability. No party hereto is obligated to expend any resources whatsoever in connection with this agreement. No implementation of any portion of this agreement, or commencement of any specific projects, may be initiated prior to the written assurance of such budgetary availability to the other party hereto. To the extent that any external funding is required by Savannah College of Art and Design in order to implement this Savannah College of Art and Design agreement and funding for such purposes is not appropriated to Savannah College of Art and Design shall hence forth have no further financial obligations hereunder. In the event Savannah College of Art and Design does not have sufficient legislative appropriations to carry out any obligations under this agreement, it shall immediately notify Pensacola State College of such portions of this agreement that may be deemed terminated as a result of such failure of appropriations.

6. Public Records

All parties shall allow public access to all documents, papers, letters, or other materials subject to the provisions of Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, and made or received in connection with this agreement. Refusal by either to allow such public access shall be grounds for unilateral cancellation of this agreement.

Term of this Agreement

1. This articulated curriculum agreement shall continue for a period of five (5) years from the effective date of execution. The effective date of this agreement shall be determined from the date of the last signature. It will be automatically renewed for an additional one (1) year period unless either party provides the other written notice no later than sixty (60) days prior to the expiration of the preceding term that it wishes to terminate this agreement. If either party fails to follow the terms and conditions of the agreement set forth therein, the other party has the right to terminate this agreement upon sixty (60) days written notice to the other.

3. Modifications, additions, or deletions from this agreement must be in writing and signed by both parties. The designated representatives for the University and the College are listed upon "Approvals."


Entire Agreement


