Credit awarded with acceptable course completion grades and Industry (NCCER) Credential as described above

Maximum length of time between graduation and awarding PJC credit: 3 years for students with NCCER Industry Certification

Credits cannot be awarded based on the above if the same courses have been attempted at PJC.
