The Nursing Department at Pensacola State College has recommended that students who complete the <a href="https://high.com/high.c

To best prepare themselves for the RN-AS program at Pensacola State, high school students are advised to:

- 1) Achieve a 3.00 GPA for high school graduation
- 2) Earn a 3.00 (no grade lower than a "B") for all Health/Science courses in their Career Academy. Those courses are:

Health Science I

Health Science II

## And either

Nursing Assistant 3 or Allied Health Assisting 3

3) Earn CNA (Certified Nursing Assistant) Industry Certification

High school students are encouraged to take the following courses:

- 1) Anatomy & Physiology
- 2) Algebra II or Precalculus (4<sup>th</sup> year of Math)

Additionally, high school students may wish to further their achieving the RN-AS Candidate status by taking college courses through Dual Enrollment. Suggested Pensacola State College courses are:

BSC 1093 – Anatomy and Physiology I

BSC 1093L – Anatomy and Physiology I Lab

BSC 1094 - Anatomy and Physiology II

BSC 1094L - Anatomy and Physiology II Lab
