**Please attach the following required documentation:**

- **Dependent Students (students required to provide parental information on FAFSA) must submit the following documents:**
  1. Student/Parent/Stepparent(s) copy of 2012 Tax Return Transcripts and all W2s.
  2. Student/Parent/Stepparent(s) copy of 2013 Tax Return Transcripts and all W2s (if submitting this information **after** Dec. 31, 2013).
  3. Student/Parent/Stepparent(s) copies of most recent pay stubs.
  4. 2013-2014 Dependent Verification Document.
- **Independent Students (students not required to provide parental information on FAFSA) must submit the following documents:**
  1. Student/Spouse copy of 2012 Tax Return Transcript and all W2s.
  2. Student/Spouse copy of 2013 Tax Return Transcripts and all W2s (if submitting this information **after** Dec. 31, 2013).
  3. Student/Spouse copies of most recent pay stubs.
  4. 2013-2014 Independent Verification Document.

**Examples of Documentation to Submit:**

- Layoff notice or letter from employer
- Proof of unemployment benefits
- Medical records, proof of disability benefits
- Social Security Statement
- Divorce decree or legal separation documents or letter from attorney stating marital status of parties involved.
- Proof of out-of-pocket expenses paid in 2012 (childcare/eldercare/medical/dental).
- Marital Status
- Proof of current income
- Death Certificate
- Workers Compensation
- Child Support Statement

**NOTE:** The Financial Aid Office will re-evaluate your financial aid eligibility **ONLY** after receiving all requested and required documentation.
