

TEAS V for AH (Allied Health)

TEAS V for AH (Allied Health) (formerly HOBET), measures basic essential skills in the academic content area of reading, mathematics, science and English and language usage. The objectives assessed on the TEAS exam are those which are deemed most appropriate and relevant to measure entry level skills and abilities of allied health program applicants.

The TEAS V AH is a computerized test consisting of 170 multiple choice questions with a time limit of 209 minutes for the test (3 hours 30 minutes).

- **Reading:** 58 minutes with 48 questions
- **Mathematics:** 51 minutes with 34 questions
- **Science:** 66 minutes with 54 questions
- **English and language usage:** 34 minutes with 34 questions

Before Making Your Appointment:

You must create an account on the **Assessment Technologies Institute, LLC (ATI) website**.

Go to www.atitesting.com and follow the steps below to create an account with ATI:

- Under the boxes for entering a Username and Password click on “Create an account.”
 - **Note:** Do not select “Register for TEAS” or you will be instructed to choose a test site elsewhere.
- Complete all items in blue.
- For the Institution, select **Pensacola State College AH**.
- Uncheck “Non-degree” box and enter expected graduation date calculated based on acceptance into the program for the semester for which you are applying.
- **Make note of the Username and Password that you created. You will need this information on test day.**
- Click on Register, to complete the process.
