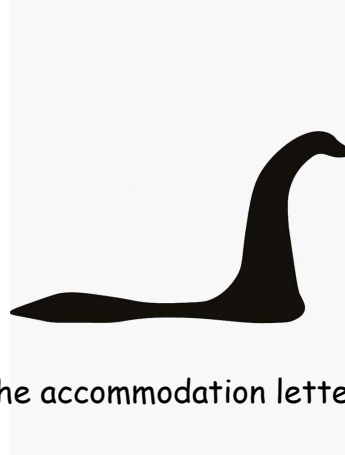


Common Accommodation Myths

- getting multiple chances on tests



These are not true, unless specifically listed on the accommodation letter.
