

**Nine Month Cost of Attendance Budget

**How is financial need calculated?**

For awarding Federal financial aid the following calculation is used:

Cost of attendance – Student Aid Index = Financial Need  
\*Total Financial Aid cannot exceed Cost of Attendance

Financial aid from all sources cannot exceed the student’s financial need. The cost of attendance (COA) includes tuition, fees, books, supplies, living expenses, transportation, and miscellaneous expenses. The Student Aid Index (SAI) is determined by the Federal Needs Analysis using the information the student/parent furnish on the FAFSA. Your SAI is utilized to determine your financial aid.

Other factors that can impact the cost of attendance are individual program specific expenses.
