The Board of Trustees authorizes and directs the President to adopt and implement Information Security and Technology Resources plans, procedures, standards, and guidelines to govern and establish standards for the protection, security, and use of electronically stored information, technology resources, and artificial intelligence systems of the College, in alignment with the college-wide Strategic Plan and in compliance with applicable federal and state laws, regulations, and rules.

Such plans, procedures, standards, and guidelines shall address the use and limitations of artificial intelligence, including instructional and business use, academic integrity, approved uses, required notifications, applicability to College constituents, and artificial intelligence literacy, as required by applicable law or rule.
