

Associate in Science in Nursing Program Outcomes

Licensure Examination Pass Rate

Florida Board of Nursing (FBON) benchmark is not more than 10 percentage points below the national average for the program type.

The Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) benchmark is the most recent annual pass rate OR the mean pass rate for the three most recent years based on first-time test takers or first-time takers and repeaters.
